Simplification	A postulate that basically suggests that each image should contain only the necessary subjects.
Rule of odds	It relates to a number of subjects on an image.
Golden ratio	You use the squares to draw a spiral that looks like a snail's shell.
Rule of space	It provides the contextual background for the represented topic and is often relative to spatial illusion.
Allover composition	When entire surface of the piece is worked on in a more or less uniform way, and the normal way of treating composition (with the picture having a center, top or bottom) is not considered.
Rule of thirds	It is linked with the division of an image into thirds horizontally and vertically in order to avoid bisecting which is not very visually pleasing.
Grouping	Clustering elements/subjects of an artwork, as opposed to scattering of the elements/subjects.

+ Appendix IV

Focal point – the point at which rays or waves meet after reflection or refraction, or the point from which diverging rays or waves appear to proceed; fokalna/ključna tačka

Imagery - visual images collectively; slikovitost, vizuelnost, zbir slika/vizuelnih predstava

Off-kilter – not in the usual, expected, or correct condition or state; neuobičajeno, nestandardno

Subject matter – the topic dealt with or the subject represented in a work of art; tema, predmet umetničkog dela

Viewpoint – a person's opinion or point of view; stanovište, gledište

Radiating lines – To extend in straight lines from or toward a center; diverge or converge like rays; radiativne linije

Integer – a whole number; a number that is not a fraction; ceo broj

Allover painting – A canvas covered in paint from edge to edge and from corner to corner, in which each area of the composition is given equal attention and significance; kompozicija zasnovana na ujednačenoj pokrivenosti platna

Confine (of the canvas) - borders or boundaries, especially with regard to their restricting freedom of movement; granica, međa (platna)
